

## Duck Island Yacht Club 2013 Bonus Points Daylight Race

## **NOTICE OF RACE**

Date: September 7, 2013

Entries: Close September 3, 2013. Entries should be created online at <a href="www.americanregatta.com/diyc">www.americanregatta.com/diyc</a>.

**Start:** In or near Duck Island Roads, Westbrook, CT. The First Warning Signal is scheduled at 0900. Time Limit for all boats is 2400 Saturday September 7, 2013.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016.

**Rule Changes:** The Sailing Instructions change several rules in addition to *Rule 77*-Appendix G-sail numbers are not required and *Race Signals*-Postponement signaled ashore. Double handed entries may use self steering devices during sail changes, changing Rule 52.

**Safety Requirements:** Jack lines and harnesses are recommended for use between sunset and sunrise; and PFDs whenever reefed. At least two persons must be aboard. Conformance to ISAF Offshore Special Regulations for Race Category 4 Monohulls is strongly encouraged.

**Courses:** The Race Committee will select and signal a course predefined in the *Sailing Instructions* immediately prior to the race. Course length will range from approximately 40 to approximately 50 nautical miles. All planned courses terminate back at Duck Island.

**Sailing Instructions:** Will be available at least one week before the first Warning on the Duck Island Yacht Club web site <a href="https://www.diyc.com">www.diyc.com</a>. Notices to Competitors will be posted on the Race Committee bulletin board located below the deck in the front of the clubhouse building, Hammock Road South, Westbrook, CT.

Classes: Spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes based on PHRF handicaps are planned.

**Eligibility:** Entrants must hold a *current, valid* PHRF-ECSA or DIYC-PHRF certificate before the *Close of Entries*. Additionally, boats must contain as a minimum, a self-bailing cockpit, fixed berths, galley facilities and the ability to be self supporting for a weekend cruise.

**Facilities:** Some slips may be available gratis at DIYC on a first come first served basis. A limited number of transient town moorings are available for boats under 32 ft LOA in the Patchogue River. Dockage may also be found at Pilots Point Marina and anchorage may be found inside Duck Island breakwaters.

## Fees:

Race Fee: \$40 per boat (\$50 for entries mailed after September 3, 2013) \$10.00 additional for entrants who are not USSA members Entries should be created online at <a href="https://www.americanregatta.com/diyc">www.americanregatta.com/diyc</a>.
