DIYC COVID-19 Racers Advisory & Protocols (6/11/2020)

USAGE & ACCESS GUIDELINES FOR DIYC CLUB PROPERTY AND EVENTS

(These guidelines are in addition to any issued by state or local authorities.)

- **If you or a guest feels sick**, has experienced COVID-19 symptoms within the past 14 days, or has within the past 14 days come into contact with someone who has COVID-19 (outside the role of medical professional), you or the guest should not come to the Club or race.
- **All who visit Club grounds or participate in racing in any role during this time should be aware of the potential risks associated with COVID-19.**
- **Wearing a face covering is mandatory in the following situations:** While within 6 feet of individuals in the restrooms, on the deck, on docks or on boats at dock or on boats while on the water. If you are within 6 feet of any other individual outside of your household (per the State of CT), face coverings need not be worn only (i) if doing so would be contrary to his/ her health or safety because of a medical condition, or (ii) for children under the age of 2.
- **Sanitize your hands (with your own hand sanitizer) immediately upon arrival to the Club by land or sea**, after going to the restroom, before and after eating, and after coughing/sneezing.
- **No more than 10 people per group**, and each group strongly recommended to be a part of the same household.
- **The Clubhouse is closed**, limited restroom usage is available from the Condo Association restrooms on the west side of the clubhouse. Bathrooms will be cleaned prior to racing, a spray bottle with a water and bleach mix will be in each men's and women's bathroom. You are asked to spray all touch surfaces before and after use. **There will be no awards or social gatherings after racing.**
- **If you use the deck furniture or outdoor hose**, bring your own disinfectant, wipe down all surfaces that you and/or your family, guests, or crew touch before and after use.
- **While this guidance provides a way for racers, race committee and all those affiliated with DIYC to enjoy racing by limiting risk, all risks to participants cannot be eliminated.** Captains and boat owners are ultimately responsible for the safety of their crews and must determine if each crew member should be on board. Captains must require signed waivers from all crew members prior to racing.
- **A touchless thermometer which will be available from race committee upon request.**
